THE WORKSHOP

RMJM is one of the largest architecture and design network in the world founded in 1956 by Robert Matthews and Stirrat Johnson Marshall.

With 29 studios across five continents and more then 1000 built projects, RMJM continue to strive for excellence and embrace the ever-evolving landscape of our industry.

RMJM Academy is an intensive summer course with educational purpose open to students and graduates of architecture.

This multidisciplinary workshop will drive applicants through a complete architectural process from the ideation to the execution.

The experience includes several activities such site visit, lectures by exponents of the world of architecture and university and final exhibition.



PURPOSE

This educational experience will give you the chance to work on the practice of **reusing architectural heritage** that is strongly recommended today.

All the lectures will give you overview about specific topic related to the subject of the workshop from case studies to the regulatory framework.

This workshop will be an opportunity to take on new challenges, to live an intensive and practical experience in order to deepen your knowledge and skills in a given project theme. It will then be possible to confront real problems, develop creative solutions and experiment with new techniques and design approaches.

THE SITE

Anconetta: Ex Ceramica Mantovana


The building is located in the old historical centre of the city of Mantua, in the Fiera Catena district, south-east of the historic center of the city.

The complex includes the old production site called "Ex Ceramica Mantovana", which since the early 1900s has been a flourishing center for the production of bricks. Around the 1960s, however, the factory began to decline and its buildings began to be used as workshops and warehouses in the general abandonment. Nevertheless, its soaring chimneys continue to dominate and characterize the urban context of Anconetta, representing an important testimony of industrial archaeology.

Next to it today stands the new school Mantegna, born from a significant urban regeneration that has determined the restoration and partial recovery of the property tied.







THE PROGRAM

The workshop program is structured in **four steps** which will be useful for the candidate in developing the project.

Specifically, there will be a guided tour on the site, three lectures on design and regulatory issues necessary for the project, active development of the project through designs and models and a final exhibition, which will allow the candidate to show the work produced during the different intensive sessions.



SITE VISIT

The survey is the time when you enter into real connection with the project area, where it is possible, through the direct visit, the development of first suggestions, of live sketches, photographs that can keep alive in memory the sensations that at first glance that place has generated.

It is therefore the moment of first analysis of the area, during which the first strengths of the space to be implemented will already emerge. Interaction with the place is therefore crucial for project development. A **guided site tour** will be conducted to offeradirectandimmersiveunderstanding of the project context. Notebooks will be provided for data collection and observational recordings throughout the visit. Participants will also be expected to take photographs to support and inform the subsequent design process.



LECTURES

The workshop will be covered by a total of three lectures dealing with specific topics related to the workshop.

In particular, **case studies** will be presented and analyzed, the **regulatory framework** for operating in the project area will also be presented and finally hints will be given to the importance of **graphics** for the presentation of projects.



DESIGN ACTIVITIES

Participants will be divided into groups in order to develop their own proposal with the supervision of RMJM staff as tutors.

There will be a total of three groups, each one composed by three members.

For the development of the project it will be necessary to be equipped with your own laptop.



FINAL EXHIBITION

The workshop will conclude with a **public exhibition** which will determine the winning proposal.

The exhibition will be open to the public and will show the works produced during the workshop, from sketches to project boards and the final model.

The winning team will receive a reward of €1500 plus an opportunity to have an **internship** at RMJM.
